



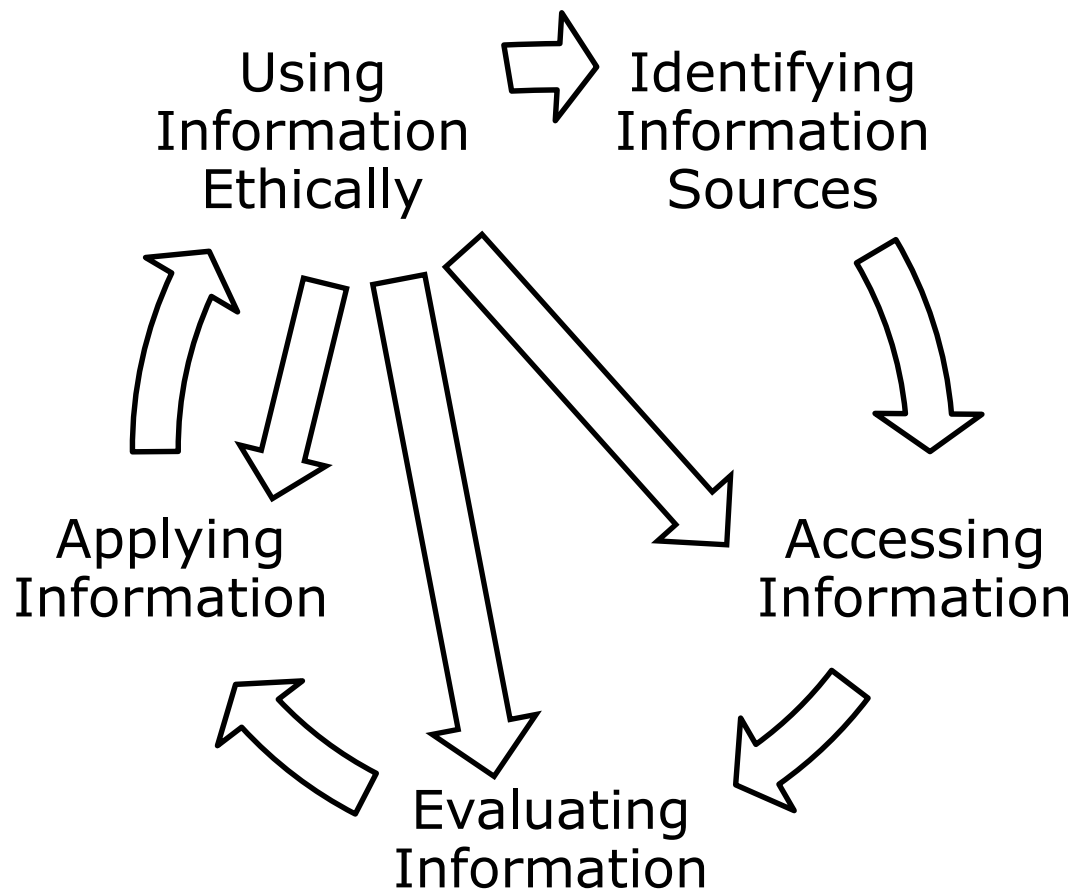
The Cycle of Law Student Information Literacy

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Elements of Law Student Info. Literacy

1. Identifying Sources (Foundational Knowledge)
 - a) Knowing the context and
 - b) Structure of Legal Information
2. Accessing Information
 - a) Selecting sources and
 - b) Strategizing research
3. Evaluating Information
 - a) In terms of reliability and
 - b) Costs/Benefits of resources
4. Applying Information
 - a) Analytically and
 - b) Iteratively
5. Using Information Ethically

Cycle of Law Student Info. Literacy



Boulder Stmts. cf. Law Student Info. Lit.

- Both reinforce the intellectual component of legal research
- Both offer tools of value to construct a pedagogy of legal research
- Both serve as a taxonomy or “scaffold” for incorporating legal research into the law school curriculum
- LSIL defines the skills that Boulder implicates; and Boulder provides the intellectual frame legitimizing the Principles and Standards
