Admission to the reception. You will need your conference badge for admittance. Guests will also need to have a badge.

Transportation. A bus will be available to carry attendees and guests to the National Civil Rights Museum. The white bus from Last Minute Transportation holds 13 people and will be parked at the SpringHill Suites entrance starting at 5:30 pm. It takes 15 min to reach the Museum. Buses will run continuously every 15 minutes from the SpringHill Suites to the Museum and back. The last bus will leave the Museum at 9:15 p.m.

You can also take the Trolley. There is a station on Main Street in back of the SpringHill Suites. The Trolley will be at this stop around every 20 minutes. It costs \$1 each way to ride. You will need exact change. Ask to get off near the Civil Rights Museum. You will need to walk down to the Museum entrance from Main Street where the Trolley stops.

Tour. The reception includes the ability to tour the Museum exhibits on your own. There are 24 exhibits. You will be able to return to the reception area from the exhibits.
